RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

4. Pursuant to European Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR) and the national legislation in force, the interested party may, in accordance with the procedures and within the limits provided for by current legislation, exercise the following rights:

- request confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning him/her (right of access of the interested party - art. 15 of Regulation 679/2016);
- know its origin
- receive intelligible communication thereof;
- have information about the logic, methods and purposes of processing;
- request its updating, rectification, integration, cancellation, transformation into anonymous form, blocking transformation into anonymous form, the blocking of data treated in violation of the law, including those no longer necessary for the pursuit of the purposes for which they were collected (right of rectification and cancellation - Articles 16 and 17 of Regulation 679/2016);
- right to limitation and/or opposition to the processing of data concerning him/her (art. 18 of Regulation 679/2016);
- right of revocation;
- right to data portability (art. 20 of Regulation 679/2016);
- in cases of processing based on consent, to receive their data provided to the owner, in structured and machine-readable form and in a format commonly used by an electronic device;
- the right to lodge a complaint with the Control Authority (right of access of the data subject - art. 15 of Regulation 679/2016).

About Cookies

What are cookies

A "cookie" is a text file saved on the user's computer when the user accesses a website for the purpose of providing information each time the user returns to the same site. It is a kind of reminder of the internet page visited. With the cookie, the web server sends information to the user's browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, etc.). stored on the user's computer, and will be read and updated every time the user returns to the site. In this way the website can automatically adapt to the user.

During browsing, the user may also receive cookies on his terminal from different sites ("third party" cookies), set directly by the managers of the websites and used for the purposes and in the manner defined by them.

Depending on their duration, they are distinguished in session cookies (i.e. those temporary and automatically deleted from the terminal at the end of the browsing session) and persistent cookies (i.e. those that remain stored on the terminal until they expire or are deleted by the user).

Depending on the function and purpose of use, cookies can be divided into technical cookies and profiling cookies.

Technical cookies

Some cookies are used to perform computer authentication, session tracking and store specific information about users accessing a web page. These so-called technical cookies are often useful to allow you to browse a website and use all of its features. Technical cookies are those whose use does not require the user's consent.

Analytics cookies also belong to this category. These are cookies that collect information about the use that a user makes of a website and that allow to improve its functioning. For example, analytics cookies show which pages are most frequently visited, allow you to see what the recurring patterns of use of a website are, and help you understand any difficulties you are experiencing in using it.

Other cookies can instead be used to monitor and profile users during navigation, study their movements and habits of web consultation or consumption (what they buy, what they read, etc..), also in order to send targeted and personalized services advertising. In this case we speak of profiling cookies. The use of said cookies requires the prior acquisition of the free informed consent of the user pursuant to art. 7 of EU Regulation 2016/679 and the national legislation in force.

Types of cookies used by our site
